The Blood Tribe Youth Wellness Centre (BTYWC) program provides 24-hour Addictions Residential Treatment Services to Blood Tribe and First Nations, Inuit and Métis Adolescents and Youth from across Canada, between the ages of 12 to 17 years of age, struggling with or at risk of drugs, alcohol, and/or addictions.

**Position Summary:** Under the supervision of the BTYWC Team Leader, the Youth Addiction Worker will conduct all aspects of the program while working with a team in the delivery of treatment based, residential programs, to effectively address the needs of our youth served; program goals and objectives must align with indigenous values and beliefs. The Youth Addition Worker will be responsible for programming structured and unstructured activities while fully participating; effective liaison with involved professionals as well as significant family members. This position will require **Shift work** including day, evening, night and or weekends and statutory holidays.

**Qualifications:** Degree or Diploma in Human Services Field with 2 years related work experience; Equivalencies: Addiction Certificate with 2 years related experience. Must have **one year sobriety**.
